

## **SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE REGULATING JUNKYARDS IN UPPER MIFFLIN TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** pursuant to *section 1601* of the Second Class Township Code that Board of Supervisors of Upper Mifflin Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania will at their regularly scheduled meeting to be held on August 9, 2022 will consider and vote on the adoption of an ordinance regulating the operation of junkyards in Upper Mifflin Township. The proposed ordinance is summarized as follows:

Section 11 Abatement after revocation or expiration of license

Section 12 Repealer, severability, and compliance with state and federal law

Section 13 This ordinance shall become effective seven days after enactment.
