REGULAR MEETING

Heidi Clevenger called to order the December 10, 2024, regular monthly meeting of the Upper Mifflin Board of Supervisors meeting located at 785 Roxbury Road, Newville, PA 17241 at 7:00 pm

Present: Chairman Heidi Clevenger, Kingsley Blasco, Heather Mitten and Secretary Valerie Mowery.

Approval of Minutes: Kingsley motioned to approve the minutes for the meeting held on November 12, 2024, Heidi seconded; all were in favor.

Acceptance of Treasurer's Report: Kingsley motioned to approve the November 12, 2024 Treasurer's report, Heather seconded; all were in favor.

Visitors: Paul Diehl, Jon Gardner-Newburg/Hopewell Fire Dept., Kim & Steve Wisner.

Paul Diehl was present to voice his concern on the fire tax that the Board may implement in the future. He was also here voicing his concern on the manure smell that has been going on near his property. Kingsley stated that there is nothing the Board can do but told him Barb Gleim is working on some new regulations that might be passed on the process of spreading the manure.

Jon Gardner from Fire Co, 51 gave his report and stated that there were 32 calls and 5 of them were in Upper Mifflin Township. He also asked when and if the fire tax would be passed and the Board stated that they are still figuring out what would be best for the Township residents.

Correspondence: Heidi went over the correspondence and mentioned what was important.

Gym:

Heather gave some information on the Disc golf that was mentioned at an earlier meeting and she says the equipment starts at \$3,000.00. The Board said maybe in the future they could bring it back up for discussion.

Old Business: None.

New Business: Kingsley made a motion to have the reorganizational meeting at 6:30 pm on January 6, 2025, and the regular January meeting at 7:00 pm the same night. Heather seconded; all were in favor.

The Board tabled appointing an individual on the Planning Commission until the next meeting.

Kingsley made a motion to write up a public notice for solicitors to call the township if they plan on being in the area so that the Board can notify resident that they will be in the area promoting their businesses. Heather seconded; all were in favor. Valerie will prepare something and send it to the Board for their approval before she puts it in the Valley Time Star.

Solicitor's Report: Sally prepared an amendment to the Nuisance Ordinance. Kingsley made a motion to adopt it, and Heidi seconded; all were in favor.

Kingsley would like Sally to look into what can be done with wells near farmers fields, such as creating an ordinance for future wells and how far they should be off property lines.

Road Master Report: Nothing new to report.

Permit Report: There was 1 Land Use application, 3 Land Use permit & 1 Septic permit issued since the last meeting.

Emergency Mgmt.: Bob stated he had nothing new to report.

Approval of Bills: Kingsley made a motion to approve the bills for payment, Heather seconded; all were in favor.

Additional Bills for Payment: Kingsley made a motion to approve the additional bills for payment, Heather seconded; all were in favor.

2025 General & State Budget: Kingsley made a motion at approve the 2025 General & State Liquid Fuels Budget, Heather seconded; all were in favor.

Adjournment: Kingsley made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:40 pm, Heidi seconded; all were in favor.
