June 13, 2023 Meeting Minutes

The Board of Supervisors of Upper Mifflin Township met on Tuesday June 13, 2023 at the Township Building, located at 455 Whiskey Run Road, Newville, PA 17241. Kingsley Blasco called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Present: Heidi Clevenger, Heather Mitten, Kingsley Blasco, Valerie Mowery

Visitors: Harold Snyder, Dan Lehman Co. 47., Trent Wagner Co. 47 & Jake Griffie Co. 47.

Approval of Minutes: Heidi motioned to approve the May 9, 2023 Meeting Minutes; Kingsley seconded; all were in favor.

Treasurer's Report: Heather motioned to approve the May 9 2023, Treasurer's Report, Kingsley seconded; all were in favor.

Visitors: Dan Lehman, Trent Wagner & Jake Griffie from Co, 47 gave a presentation for the firehouse that is looking to get a paid driver for Fire Side and EMS Administrator. They made mention that the volunteers have declined in the past several years and the average response time is going up on fire calls and EMS calls. They feel that it would be beneficial to have a paid driver 24-7 to respond to calls quicker. The Board is going to look into see what can be done to help the fire station out.

Correspondence: Kingsley looked through the correspondence and made mention of what was important. He read a letter that he received from FEMA.

Approval of Bills: Heidi motioned to approve the bills for payment, Heather seconded; all were in favor.
